

HUBUNGAN PERAN ORANG TUA DENGAN PERILAKU MENCUCI TANGAN PADA ANAK USIA SEKOLAH SELAMA PANDEMI COVID-19 DI WILAYAH KERJA PUSKESMAS GAMPING I

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INTISARI

Latar Belakang: Perilaku cuci tangan di masa pandemi COVID-19 menjadi kewajiban setiap individu termasuk anak usia sekolah. Berdasarkan fenomena yang ada AUS memiliki kebiasaan tidak selalu memperhatikan perilaku cuci tangan perilaku tersebut dapat menyebabkan penyakit. Orang tua adalah *role model* bagi anak-anaknya dalam menerapkan protokol kesehatan, salah satunya dipengaruhi oleh peran orang tua memiliki peran aktif dalam mengasuh anak, diantaranya pemenuhan kebutuhan anak, memberikan kasih sayang dan perhatian, menjaga kesehatan dan melindungi anak di masa pandemi dengan menerapkan 6M. Perilaku mencuci tangan menggunakan sabun merupakan salah satu pencegahan penyebaran COVID-19.

Tujuan: Mengetahui hubungan peran orang tua dengan perilaku mencuci tangan pada anak usia sekolah selama pandemi COVID-19 di wilayah kerja Puskesmas Gamping I.

Metode: Merupakan penelitian kuantitatif korelasi, dengan pendekatan *cross-sectional*. Jumlah sampel yang digunakan pada penelitian ini adalah 82 orang. Teknik pengambilan data menggunakan kuesioner peran orang tua dan kuesioner perilaku mencuci tangan. Analisis data yang digunakan adalah analisis univariabel dan analisis bivariabel *Rank Spearman*.

Hasil: Peran orang tua dan perilaku mencuci tangan pada anak usia sekolah dalam kategori positif sebesar 81,7% dan 59,8%. Terdapat hubungan antara Peran orang tua dan perilaku mencuci tangan pada anak usia sekolah nilai *p* sebesar 0,000 dan koefisien kolerasi 0,512.

Kesimpulan: Ada hubungan antara peran orang tua dengan perilaku mencuci tangan pada anak usia sekolah selama pandemi COVID-19 di wilayah kerja Puskesmas Gamping I.

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**THE CORRELATION OF PARENTS' ROLE ON THE HAND-WASHING
BEHAVIOR OF THE CHILDREN AT SCHOOL AGE DURING THE
PANDEMIC OF COVID-19 IN THE WORKING AREA OF PUSKESMAS
GAMPING 1**

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ABSTRACT

Background Hand washing behavior during the COVID-19 pandemic has been the obligation of every individual, including school-age children. Based on the existing phenomena, school age children have the tendency of skipping hand-wash behavior which may cause diseases. Parents are role models for their children in implementing health protocols, one of which is influenced by the role of parents in playing an active role in educating children, including fulfilling children's needs, providing love and attention, maintaining health and protecting children during the pandemic by applying the 6M. Washing hands with soap is one way to prevent the spread of COVID-19.

Objective: To find out the correlation of parents' role on the hand-washing behavior of children at school age during the Covid-19 pandemic in the working area of Puskesmas Gamping 1.

Methods: This research was correlation quantitative with cross-sectional approach. The sample used involved 82 people. The data collection technique used was through parental role questionnaire and hand-wasing behavior questionnaire. The data analysis used was the univariable analysis and bivariable analysis of Rank Spearman.

Results: The role of parents and hand washing behavior in school-age children are in the positive category of respectively 81.7% and 59.8%,. There is a correlation between the role of parents and handwashing behavior in school-age children, the p-value is 0.000 and the correlation coefficient is 0.512.

Conclusion: There is a correlation between parents' role and the hand-washing behavior of children at school age during the Covid-19 pandemic in the working area of Puskesmas Gamping 1.
