CONTINUOUS MIDWIFERY CARE FOR MRS.E 27 YEARS OLD MULTIPARA AT CLINIC PRATAMA AMANDA SLEMAN YOGYAKARTA

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ABSTRAK

Background : The problem of mothers and children is still a big problem in Indonesia especially pregnant women, childbirth, childbirth, newborns, and family planning, this is still due to the high rate of maternal mortality. Factors that often occur at 22 weeks gestation are latitude, complications at latitude are uterine rupture either spontaneously or during extraction, prolonged labor and premature rupture of membranes. Treatment efforts by teaching the position of the knee chest and providing care on an ongoing basis starting from pregnancy, childbirth, puerperal and neonatal quality.

Objective : To be able to carry out continuous midwifery care for Ny.E, a 27-year old multipara at the Amanda Primary Clinic.

Method : Descriptive research type, with a case study approach.

Results : Midwifery care in Ny.E was carried out ANC 4 times UK 22 weeks, had a latitude pregnancy and was given knee chest care. UK 27 + 3 weeks, mother was leucorrhoea and was given care of IEC genetalia cleanliness. Labor is normal and there are no complications. BBL is in normal condition and there are no complications. BBL under normal conditions. KF done 3 times, KF2 ASI came out a little and was given care of oxytocin massage. KN is done 3 times, KN 2 is done baby massage.

Conclusion : Pregnancy care for Multipurpose 27 years old Ny.E in Amanda Pratama Clinic Sleman Regency is in accordance with midwifery service standards and there is no gap between theory and practice.
