MAHASISWA KEBIDANAN (S-1) UNIVERSITAS JENDERAL

Latar Belakang: Donor darah merupakan kegiatan penting dalam pelayanan Kesehatan untuk membantu pasien yang membutuhkan transfusi darah. Namun ketersediaan darah di Indonesia belum mencukupi kebutuhan nasional. Kurangnya pengetahuan masyarakat, termasuk mahasiswa, menjadi salah satu penyebab rendahnya partisipasi donor darah.

Tujuan Penelitian: Mengetahui gambaran tingkat pengetahuan tentang donor darah pada Mahasiswa Kebidanan (S-1) Universitas Jendral Achmad Yani Yogyakarta Tahun 2025.

Metode Penelitian: Penelitian ini menggunakan metode deskriptif kuantitatif. Populasi dalam penelitian ini adalah mahasiswa program studi kebidanan (S-1). Teknik pengambilan sampel menggunakan *quota sampling* dengan jumlah responden sebanyak 40 mahasiswa. Pengumpulan data dilakukan dengan menyebarkan kuesioner melalui link *Google Form*.

Hasil Penelitian: Hasil penelitian tentang Gambaran pengetahuan donor darah pada mahasiswa kebidanan (S-1) adalah berpengetahuan baik 16 responden (40%), 12 responden (30%) berpengetahuan cukup, dan 12 responden (30%) berpengetahuan kurang.

Kesimpulan: Tingkat pengetahuan mahasiswa Kebidanan (S-1) tentang donor darah bervariasi, namun mayoritas berpengetahuan baik sebanyak 16 responden (40%).

THE OVERVIEW OF KNOWLEDGE ON BLOOD DONATION AMONG MIDWIFEY (BACHELOR'DEGREE) STUDENTS AT UNIVERSITAS JENDRAL ACHAMAD YANI YOGYAKARTA IN 2025

ABSTRACT

Background: Blood donation is an important activity in health services to help patients who need blood transfusions. However, the availability of blood in Indonesia is not yet sufficient for national needs. The lack of public knowledge, including among university students, is one of the causes of low blood donor participation.

Research Objective: To understand the level of knowledge on blood donation among Midwifery (Bachelor's Degree) students at Universitas Jenderal Achmad Yani Yogyakarta in 2025.

Research Method: This study used a quantitative descriptive method. The population consisted of students of Midwifery (Bachelor's Degree) study program. The sampling technique used was *quota sampling*, with a total of 40 student respondents. The data collection was carried out by distributing questionnaires through a *Google Form* link.

Result: The results of the study on the overview of knowledge on blood donation among Midwifery (Bachelor's Degree) students show that 16 respondents (40%) have good knowledge, 12 respondents (30%) have moderate knowledge, and 12 respondents (30%) have poor knowledge.

Conclusion: The level of knowledge on blood donation among Midwifery (Bachelor's Degree) students varies, but the majority of students, as many as 16 respondents (40%), have good knowledge.
