TINGKAT PENGETAHUAN IBU HAMIL TENTANG KUNJUNGAN ULANG KEHAMILAN TRIMESTER III DI PUSKESMAS BANGUNTAPAN II BANTUL

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Latar Belakang: Kematian ibu juga diwarnai oleh hal-hal non teknis yang masuk kategori penyebab mendasar seperti taraf pengetahuan, sikap, dan perilaku ibu hamil yang masih rendah, dengan melihat angka kunjungan kehamilan keempat kali yang masih kurang sebesar 78,77% sedangkan standar acuan nasional sebesar 95%. Rendahnya cakupan K4 dipengaruhi oleh pengetahuan tentang kunjungan ulang yang disebabkan kurangnya informasi. Sehingga masih ditemukan ibu hamil yang tidak patuh melakukan kunjungan ulang kehamilan.

Tujuan: Diketuinya tingkat pengetahuan ibu hamil tentang kunjungan ulang kehamilan trimester III di Puskesmas Banguntapan II Bantul Tahun 2016.

Metode Penelitian: Metode penelitian ini deskriptif kuantitatif. Pengambilan sampel dengan teknik *accidental sampling* berjumlah 41 responden. Alat ukur kuesioner, sedangkan analisa data menggunakan analisis *univariat*.

Hasil: Tingkat pengetahuan tentang pengertian dan tujuan ANC dalam kategori baik sebanyak 31 responden (75,6%), tingkat pengetahuan tentang manfaat dan standar ANC dalam kategori baik sebanyak 15 responden (36,6%), tingkat pengetahuan tentang jadwal dan tempat ANC dalam kategori cukup sebanyak 20 responden (48,8%), tingkat pengetahuan tentang hal-hal yang diperhatikan dalam ANC dalam kategori baik sebanyak 26 responden (63,4%), dampak tidak melakukan ANC dalam kategori baik sebanyak 24 responden (58.5%).

Kesimpulan: Hasil penelitian didapatkan bahwa pengetahuan ibu hamil tentang kunjungan ulang kehamilan di Puskesmas Banguntapan II Bantul Tahun 2016 dalam kategori cukup sebanyak 22 responden (51,2%). Sehingga pihak Puskesmas lebih meningkatkan lagi kualitas pelayanan.

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ABSTRACT

THE KNOWLEDGE LEVEL OF EXPECTANT MOTHER ABOUT ANTENATAL CARE RE-VISIT IN III TRIMESTER IN BANGUNTAPAN HEALTH CENTER COMMUNITY II BANTUL

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Background: Maternal deaths are caused by non-technical matters that is included in fundamental causes such as the low of knowledge level, attitudes, and behavior of expectant mothers. It is show at the fourth pregnancy revisit that still less by 78.77%, besides standard national average of 95%. The lack of expectant mother's knowledge level due to lack of information and understanding of the guidelines for Maternal and Child Health (MCH), particularly in the pregnancy revisit.

Objective: This study aims toknow the knowledglevel of expectant mothers about third trimester pregnancy revisit in Banguntapan Health Center Community II Bantulin2016.

Methods: This study is descriptive quantitative method. This used accidental sampling technique to collect the data, amount of 41 respondents became the sample. The measuring deviceswere questionnaire.The data are analyzedbyunivariate analysis.

Results: The knowledge level of meaning and purpose of the ANC understandingisinadequate categories that showed by 31 respondents (75.6%), the knowledge level of the benefits and ANC standards wasinadequate categories that showed by15 respondents (36.6%), the knowledge level of the schedule and ANC standard is in good category that showed in 20 respondents (48.8%), the knowledge level about things consider to ANC was in good category that showed in 26 respondents (63.4%), the effect of not doing ANC was in good category that showed in 24 respondents (58.5%).

Conclusion: The results showed that the knowledge of expectant mothers about the pregnancyrevisitinBanguntapanHealth Center Community II Bantulin2016 was in the adequate category that showed in 22 respondents (51.2%). Therefore, the health center community may improve the quality of service.
