INTISARI

Latar Belakang : *Golden ages* merupakan masa-masa penting dalam tumbuh kembang manusia yang tidak dapat diulang. Dalam masa ini sangat diperlukannya perhatian dari orang-orang terdekat secara psikis dan fisik, jika hal itu tidak didapatkan maka ditakutkan apabila terjadi penyimpangan akan tidak terdeteksi dan mempengaruhi perkembangan anak selanjutnya, seperti pertumbuhan fisik anak yang tidak sesuai umur, dan secara psikologis anak akan menjadi susah bersosialisasi, dan nakal. Berdasarkan studi pendahuluan yang dilakukan di PAUD diketahui 10 dari 28 ibu tidak mengerti tentang *golden ages* anak.

Tujuan Penelitian: Diketuinya gambaran pengetahuan ibu tentang *golden ages* anak.

Metode: Penelitian ini merupakan jenis penelitian *survey* yang bersifat deskriptif dengan pendekatan kuantitatif. Pengambilan sampel dengan teknik *total sampling* dengan jumlah 35 orang ibu yang menitipkan anaknya di PAUD. Analisis data menggunakan *univariate*.

Hasil Penelitian: Pengetahuan ibu tentang definisi *golden ages* anak mayoritas cukup sebanyak 10 orang (42,9%), masa-masa penting tumbuh kembang anak mayoritas baik sebanyak 24 orang (68,6%), pertumbuhan dan perkembangan otak mayoritas baik sebanyak 18 orang (51,4%), stimulasi pertumbuhan dan perkembangan otak mayoritas baik sebanyak 17 orang (48,6%).

Kesimpulan: Gambaran pengetahuan ibu tentang *golden ages* anak adalah baik sebanyak 18 orang (51,4%). Diharapkan kepada kepala PAUD Among Lare mengadakan penyuluhan tentang *golden ages* untuk para ibu wali murid.

ABSTRACT

Background: The Golden ages are critical periods in human growth and development that can not be repeated. In this period much needed attention from people nearby, as well as psychological and physical support, if that's not getted then will be affect event of deviation will can't be detected and subsequently in child development, such as physical growth of children who are not age-appropriate, and the child would be difficulty socializing psychologically, and mischievous. Based on preliminary studies carried out in note 10 of the 28 early childhood mother did not understand about the golden ages of children.

Objective: Knowledgeable overview of knowledge mother of the golden ages child.

Methods: This study is a survey research type is descriptive, this research was conducted with a quantitative approach, sampling with a total sampling methods, large sample of 35 mother who leave their children in early childhood (PAUD), analysis of the data using univariate.

Results: The result of knowledge mother's about the definition of golden ages quite as many as 10 children the majority of people (42.9%), critical periods of child development a good majority of as many as 24 people (68.6%), the majority of brain growth and development both as many as 18 people (51.4%), brain stimulation of the growth and development of both the majority of as many as 17 people (48.6%).

Conclusion: Knowledge mother's description of the golden ages in early childhood is well as much 18 people (51.4%). For principal among lare early childhood's hoped can give counseling about the golden ages of the mothers parents.
